Minutes of the IQAC Meeting

At the beginning Prof. S. S. Patil welcomed all the members for meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Tatyasaheb Kore Institute of Engineering and Technology, Warananagar.

Agenda No. 1: Review and Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (3rd August, 2021)

• Prof. S. S. Patil (IQAC Coordinator) read the key points of the minutes of meeting held on 3rd August, 2021 and requested all the members for approval of the same. All the members unanimously approved the minutes of meeting held on 3rd August, 2021.

Agenda No. 2: Review of Syllabus Setting for T.Y. B. Tech under Autonomous

- Prof. S. A. Desai (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Chemical Engg.) suggested to
 include more industry relevant topics into curriculum wherever possible to make
 students ready for job and reduce the learning curve for employed students.
- Dr. K. Srinivas recommended forming a sub-committee in each department to conduct
 a comprehensive review and propose necessary revisions for including industry
 relevant topics. He also expressed his views on necessity to reduce the gap between
 academia and industry.

Agenda No. 3: Consideration of Suggestions from Academic Council and Board of Studies

• Prof. G. S. Kamble (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Mech. Engg.) read out important and valuable suggestions provided by Academic Council members as well as members of Board of Studies. Especially about Honors Degree and final year B. Tech structure. He also expressed the importance of implementing these changes to conform to the policies prescribed by AICTE. I was unanimously decided to make necessary changes in Honors Degree and the structure of final year B. Tech.

Agenda No. 4: Review and Discussion on Admission Process for Academic Year 2022-23

- Dr. A. V. Patil (Admission In-charge) discussed different activities undertaken for admission campaigning for academic year 2022-23. He explained the admission process and related important dates. He also informed the committee members about arrangements made for effectively conducting CAP activities.
- Dr. S. Anekar (Chairperson), suggested necessary changes in CAP Centre to provide better experience to students and parents visiting CAP Centre. He insisted on measures to be taken in order to attract bright and diverse pool of applicants.

Agenda No. 5: Proposal for Final Year B. Tech Structure, Including Capstone Project and Industrial Internship Pattern

- Prof. S. S. Patil (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of E & Tc Engg.) proposed the plan of
 offering two distinct patterns known as Capstone Project Pattern and Industrial
 Internship Pattern for final year B. Tech students.
- Prof. I. I. Tamboli (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of CSE) and Prof. A. V. Patil (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Mech. Engg.) expressed their concern about enough opportunities for Industrial Internship Pattern and emphasized the need for collaboration with industry to facilitate meaningful internships. Other members also suggested that assistance from Training and Placement Team can be helpful. Need for clear and specific policy for Industrial Internship Pattern was also emphasized.

Agenda No. 6: Approval of Student and Faculty Training Activities for Upcoming Academic Year

- Prof. P. J. Patil (Training and Placement Officer) shared a placement status of previous academic year 2021-22 including major recruiters and package offered by the companies. He also discussed the training activities planned for final year students of academic year 2022-23. Prof. S. S. Patil (IQAC Coordinator) emphasized on arranging workshop on National Education Policy for all faculty.
- Dr. S. V. Anekar (Chairperson) appreciated the efforts taken by Training and Placement Cell for placements. He recommended expanding the scope of student and faculty training activities to include soft skills development, research methodologies, and pedagogical training. Mr. Rajesh Desai (Nominee from Industrialist) proposed inviting external experts to conduct specialized workshops.

Agenda No. 7: Overview of Teaching-Learning Activities and Exam Cell Operations During Last Semester

 Dr. Mrs. V. D. Patil (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Applied Science) highlighted the importance of continuous assessment and feedback mechanisms to improve teaching-learning activities. She suggested incorporating innovative teaching methods and digital tools to enhance student engagement and learning outcomes.

 Dr. K. Srinivas (Nominee from Alumni) emphasized the importance of continuous assessment and feedback mechanism in view of accreditation agencies like NAAC and NBA.

 Prof. M. B. Kulkarni (Controller of Examination) shared the Exam Cell activities performed during last semester of academic year 2021-22 for F.Y./S.Y./T.Y./Final Year B. Tech and M. Tech Program.

Agenda No. 8: Any other matter to be discussed with the permission of the chairperson

Prof. S. A. Desai (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Chemical Engg.) with permission
of Chairperson raised concerns about infrastructure maintenance and suggested
allocating funds for equipment upgrades and facility improvements.

• Dr. S. V. Anekar (Chairperson) promised to give serious consideration to his suggestions and take appropriate measures with management permissions.

At the beginning Prof. S. S. Patil welcomed all the members for meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Tatyasaheb Kore Institute of Engineering and Technology, Warananagar.

Agenda No. 1: Review and Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (27th August, 2022)

• Prof. S. S. Patil (IQAC Coordinator) read the key points of the minutes of meeting and corresponding action taken for a meeting held on 27th August, 2022 and requested all the members for approval of the same. All the members unanimously approved the minutes of meeting held on 27th August, 2022.

Agenda No. 2: Review of Institute's Ongoing Academic Schedule and Planning

Prof. G. S. Kamble (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Mech. Engg. & Associate Dean Academics) provided an overview of the academic schedule for current semester for F.Y. B. Tech, S.Y. B. Tech, T.Y. B. Tech, Final Year B. Tech, F.Y. M. Tech and S.Y. M. Tech programs. I was suggested that TKIET conducts In Sem Exams and End Sem Exams as per academic calendar published at the beginning of academic year 2022-23.

Agenda No. 3: To present, deliberate and take approval for AQAR to be submitted to NAAC

- Prof. G. B. Kamble (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Applied Science) presented NAAC AQAR for academic year 2021-22, providing an overview of the NAAC AQAR process and discussing qualitative as well as quantitative parameters in the AQAR.
- Prof. I. A. Mursal (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Civil Engg.) pointed some missing data on faculty development activities and suggested to include it.
- Prof. I. I. Tamboli (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of CSE) recommended highlighting notable achievements and innovations in teaching and learning methodologies.

 Prof. S. S. Patil (IQAC Coordinator) sought permission for submitting the NAAC AQAR 2021-22 to NAAC after suggestions from Prof. I. A. Mursal and Prof. I. I. Tamboli are incorporated. All IQAC members granted permission to proceed with submission.

Agenda No. 4: Discuss research and innovation initiatives of the Institute

- Current research projects undertaken by Ph.D. pursuing faculty and PG students were reviewed.
- Dr. Mrs. V. D. Patil (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Applied Science) recommended seed money should be provided by the Institute and recommended establishing interdisciplinary research collaborations to address real life societal challenges especially by farming community.
- Dr. Sudhakar Khot (Nominee from management) recommended organizing workshops to promote research culture among students.

Agenda No. 5: Discuss Outcome Based Education (OBE) and measures to be taken

- Prof. G. S. Kamble (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Mech. Engg. & Associate Dean Academics) reviewed progress of Outcome Based Education and challenges in implementing OBE. According to him the major challenges were Limited faculty training on outcome-based education and Inadequate student engagement with assessment processes.
- Dr. K. Srinivas (Nominee from Alumni) suggested to perform comprehensive review
 of the curriculum to ensure alignment with COs and POs and Investing in faculty
 development programs focused on outcome-based teaching and assessment. He also
 suggested Implementing innovative assessment methods to better evaluate student
 learning.

Agenda No. 6: Review of different statutory committees

• Dr. S. V. Anekar (Chairperson) reviewed different statutory committees such as Governing body, Academic Council, Board of Studies, Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), Grievance Redressal, Anti Ragging, Finance. Also discussed their efficacy in smooth functioning of the Institute and compliance with regulating bodies.

Agenda No. 7: Review of cocurricular and extracurricular activities in the Institute

• Prof. A. V. Patil (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Mechanical Engg.) reviewed current co-curricular and extracurricular activities being conducted in the institute.

Various activities such as technical workshops, seminars, sports events, cultural festivals, and community outreach programs were discussed.

• During discussion strengths of such activities such as high student engagement, diverse

participation, and successful outcomes of certain events were identified. Areas for

improvement such as enhancing participation in technical activities, improving

infrastructure for sports and cultural events were also identified.

• Future activities were brainstormed, taking into account the identified strengths and

areas for improvement. Prof. S. S. Patil (Teacher's Representative, Dept. of Mechanical

Engg.) suggested organizing more interdisciplinary events, conducting leadership

development programs, hosting industry-sponsored hackathons etc. It was emphasized

to align the activities with the overall educational objectives and to provide

opportunities for holistic development of students
